- Switzerland: CHF 2000,00

Les Clefs d'Or Australia has recently collaborated with Australian Executive Traveller an online publication with wide readership with top tier hotel and frequent flyers. We will continue to build on this relationship and others to provide exposure of the Les Clefs d'Or brand and the work that our members do.

On the events side we are extremely busy especially at State levels in organizing Tourism Expos, Familiarisations and Charitable events. Thank you to all our members who contribute to ensure the success of these events. Particularly our State Directors who put their hearts and souls into making things happen for their local members. The approximate time for an interview is generally 2.5-3.5 hours and the recommendation of the committee is then handed to the executive for final approval. I did note that some sections were interested in understanding the Australian methodology at the recent congress and I encourage any section looking to strengthen their methodology in relation to interviews to contact our interview committee chairman **Mr Josh Blake** (Chef Concierge – Four Seasons Sydney).

The Australian Tourism Expos have been carried out now for several years and are the brainchild of former long standing member and valued friend of Les Clefs d'Or Mr Nick Bocock. Nick has a background in creating and presenting educational materials on exceptional service and to highlight his achievements he has been asked by the international executive to assist with customer service training in the Kingdom of Bhutan. The tourism expos are a great idea for any section wanting to provide a platform for suppliers to showcase their product to a large audience of Concierge and front desk staff whilst bringing in some great revenue to ensure the ongoing viability of our society. It is basically in a "speed dating" (Nick would hate me to describe it like this!) style whereby each exhibitor is given 3-5 minutes to give an overview of their product, exchange details with the respective Concierge and provide materials. At the end of the time period a bell or musical notification signals a change of table and so on and so forth until the time limit (2-3 hours depending on numbers) is complete. Recently our Western Australian section with only 3 members conducted a successful Expo in the city of Perth and brought in some excellent funds for the society so it is a viable tool in any size section.

If any section is considering fundraising events, this method is excellent for both Concierge to extend their knowledge but also for your suppliers to build relationships and boost their profile within the Concierge community. If you would like any information about how we operate these please reach out and the Australian section would be more than happy to assist in sharing of format etc and expertise.

Australia will be holding it's AGM mid-year in Melbourne and as always we will extend invitations to our brothers in New Zealand to join and present on what's happening in Aotearoa.

I'd like to extend my sincere thanks and gratitude to the entire Turkish Section for their amazing hospitality in Istanbul!
